What follows are the initial guidelines that will be implemented for Gompers Reopening. It should be kept in mind that our ultimate guideline is the HealthyVerify plan (please refer to our website for additional information) and if there is a contradiction, that document will take precedence.

The purpose of these guidelines is to ensure the health and safety of our members, students and staff to the best of our ability.

KEY GUIDELINES

- All staff and members will be required to have their temperatures taken and complete a health screening daily.
- All staff will be required to wear masks anytime they are in program areas or in meetings.
- All members and students will be encouraged to wear masks. For DTA and the school, we understand that some members may not be able to tolerate them. Please keep in mind that for Employment Service members, some businesses may require them. If a company we are working with requires it, and the member refuses to wear it, that will mean they must be moved to a different job.
- Gompers will not be providing transportation services initially when we reopen except for the following two categories of individuals:
 - ✓ Students who Gompers provides transportation for
 - ✓ Any member of our DTA or Employment program who utilize a wheelchair

All other families will be asked to bring their loved ones to program and drop them off at the designated drop off points.

- Visitors will not be permitted into the program areas for the at least the first 30 days we are reopened. Visitors include, but are not limited to:
 - ✓ Therapists
 - ✓ DDD Nurses
 - ✓ DDD Support Coordinators
 - ✓ Family members

Gompers campuses will have clean rooms where these individuals can meet the member/student during program hours that does not impact the program areas.

- Visitors who do come to Gompers must have their temperature taken and complete a health screening.
- Sammy G's at the Phoenix Campus and Employment Services, and Bubba's Café at the Blythe Campus, will be closed for walk up service. However, we are setting up no contact delivery systems so that members can order food from their room and have it delivered.
- Until further notice there will not be any community outings.
- The playground and garden areas at the Phoenix Campus will be closed.
- The gymnasium at the Phoenix Campus will be open, but strict scheduling protocols will be put in place.
- Gompers will be cancelling all large-scale events through the end of 2020. These include but are not limited to:
 - ✓ Assemblies
 - ✓ Fishing Trip
 - ✓ Thanksgiving Celebration
 - ✓ Dances
